Wildlands Conservancy's Bike & Boat Adventure is an exciting outdoor-learning, paddle/peddling excursion. This single day, 5-hour trip starts at Canal Park in Allentown with a canoe safety review and a short practice paddle period in the canal before we start out along the Lehigh River. We stop at Sterner's Island along the way for a little exploration and take out at Sand Island in Bethlehem. Lunch will be served at this time. We then enjoy a leisurely bicycle ride back to Allentown along the canal's tow path. Bicycles, canoes, and other safety equipment that may be needed (PFDs, helmets, etc.) are provided. We also have certified safety instructors that accompany every group.
